

# Family Scouting Programs Summary

## 2018/19

### **Cub Scouts** (ages 5-10)

In increasing order of age, cub scouts are divided into the following dens: Lions, Tigers, Wolves, Bears, Webelos, Arrow of Light.

Packs may elect to be all-girl; all-boy; or be a mixture of girl and boy dens.

For Girl Dens: the 2-deep leadership must include a YPT-2 trained female.

Pack and Webelos Den Overnights: Male AND female adult leaders must be present on all overnight scouting trips and outings, even those including parent and child, unless all youth and adults are the same gender. Both male and female adult leaders must be 21 years of age and youth protection trained. At least one must be a registered member of the BSA.

### **Scouts BSA** (formerly Boy Scouts) (ages 11-18)

Girls can sign up in all-girl troops starting Feb. 2019.

The Girl Troops may be independent or associated with a Boy Troop.

Girl Troops associated with Boy Troops may use the same number.
